MESSAGE OF WELCOME TO STEAMFEST 2025 Thirty Years on and a whole new look

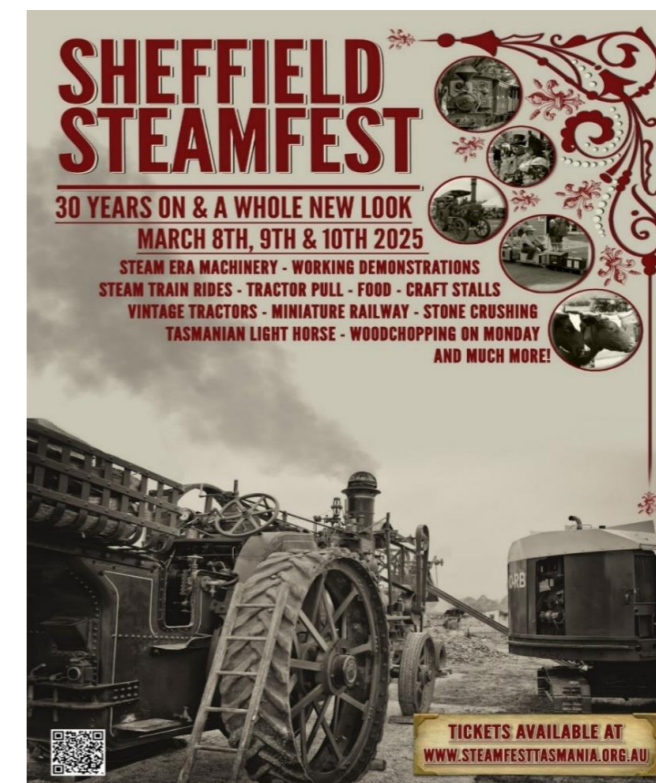

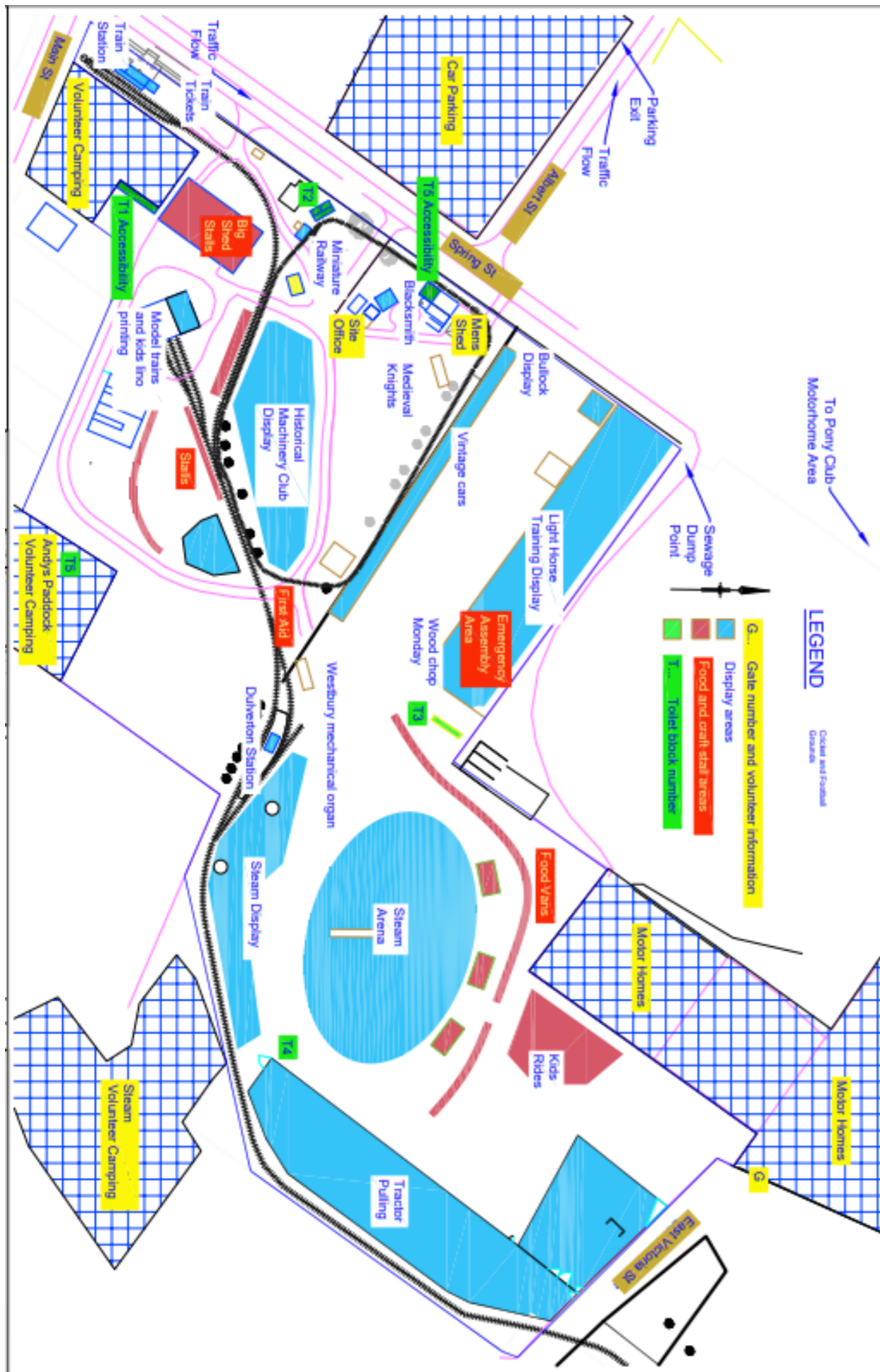
From the first SteamFest in 1994 to today the public support for the event and the development of our site continues to drive our team to preserve our steam era machinery and the skills of yesteryear.
